CONCEPT PRESENTATION



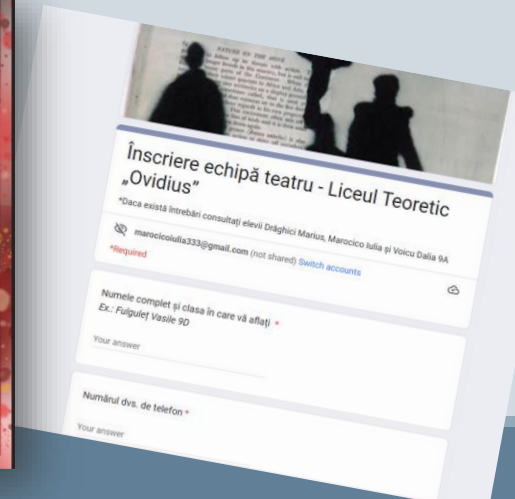
