After we decided we wanted to make this project a reality, we started promoting it to our colleagues as followed:

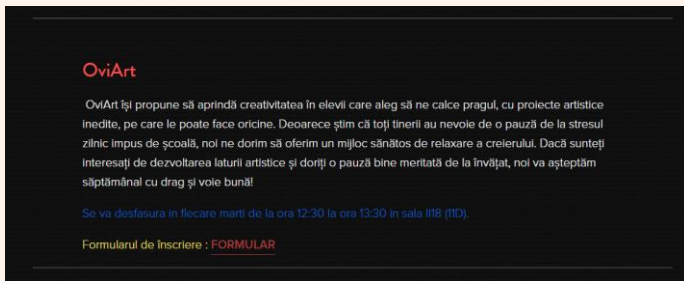
>We made a digital poster that we sent on the class leaders' Whatsapp group, along with a message explaining what the club is about and how they can sign up for it

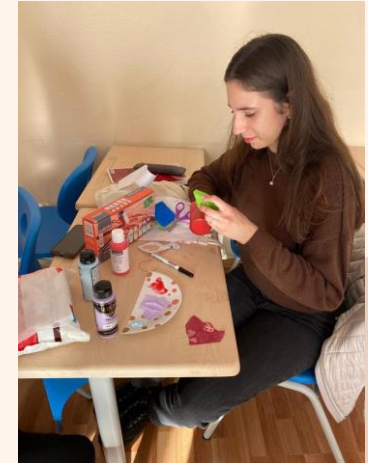


# 17.01.23–Second activity: we had 4 attendants.

# What we learned and what we would like to improve in the future

# What we learned and what we would like to improve

# What we learned and what we would like to improve
