We had 6 contestants and a large audience, about 50 spectators. We have also been live on Instagram for the students that couldn't make it and had around 40 viewers.

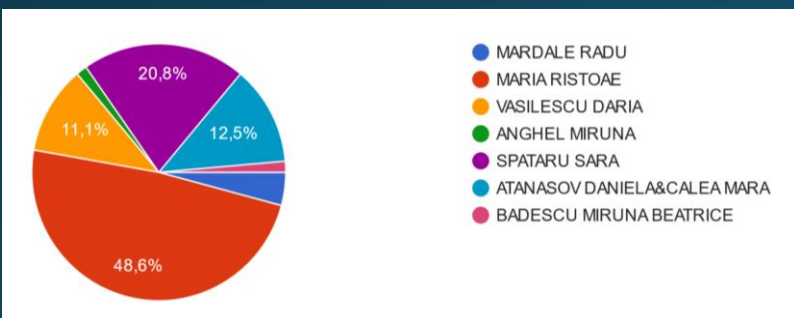
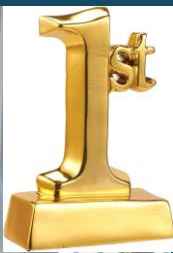


In the end we succeeded in creating a fun experience for everyone and lovely atmosphere. If you wish to see the contestant we also have a Youtube channel:
