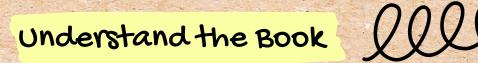

Add Text, Effects and Voiceover

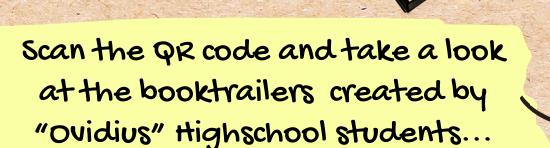
